Pointers for Folder 18

This folder helps the individual to ask simple, but profound, questions about ourselves: our beliefs, our hopes and our fears.

There is a reality: no one cares about whether or not you are innocent or guilty while you are here—you ARE already here. The question remains, will I change my attitude to be able to overcome all the difficult times ahead of me?

By changing my attitude I will be able to have the courage to change. By changing I will be able address the fears that trouble me and sometimes paralyze me.

In this folder we encourage the men to talk about their anger, their belief, and their worries and invite them to take their spiritual cry seriously and act on them.

Let us take this God stuff seriously. We ask ourselves, do I truly believe in God?

We invite the men to look for freedom right here and right now—they might have our bodies, but they don't have our souls.

It will be better to be free despite the fact that we're in jail—then to be physically free on the outside yet chained by own demons.

We challenge the individual to look, and to reach out, for the real meaning of freedom in their heart—recognizing that there is a bigger prison then just the walls now surrounding them.
