Pointers for Folder 14

In this folder we get very serious and invite ourselves to look in the mirror in such a way that we may see our own life and who we are as clearly as possible.

A man needs to look in the mirror and see the stages of the reflection. First, he might see his appearance and be mindful of his physical characteristics—he may not even like what he sees—and then change his position to make his reflection look better.

We wonder if we do the same thing with our spiritual reflection in a never-ending desire to know where we are in our relationship with God. Are we changing our position to make us feel better about our soul?

In this folder we need to remind ourselves and recognize that it is hard for all of us to remember that we are spiritual beings. We can get caught up in only seeing the reflection that we like to see but if we pay close attention we will notice that our spirit is thirsting for a better relationship with our creator.

In this folder we use the image of a man looking at himself and we ask him to honestly see reality—then we hear the spiritual challenge of changing that perception to a more intimate relationship with our spirit.

We don't have to do this alone. We have a willing God to help us. We have tools available at our disposal, like courage, wisdom, knowledge, and understanding.

All this can only happen when we are capable of seeing our spiritual reality.
